MUHAMMAD IN THE BIBLE

1. **John 1: 19-25**...After Jesus and John a third prophet was being expected.
2. **Deuteronomy 18: 18**... A Prophet like Moses would come from among Ishmalites.
3. **Revelation 19: 10-16**...A man with prophetic spirit to come to the world after Jesus.
4. **Deuteronomy 33: 1-3**...Three mountains symbolising the birth places of Moses, Jesus and Muhammad (M.P.B.T.)
5. **John 16: 7-16**... The Spirit of Truth to come after Jesus.

Call to Prayer

1. **Revelation 7: 10-11**...Angels called loudly the praises of God before worshipping Him on their faces.
2. **Nehemiah 9: 4**...The Israelites called out loudly the praises of God before worshipping.

Ablution as according to the Bible

1. **Exodus 30: 17-24**...Moses was charge with an injunction to teach the Israelites to wash both hands and legs before entering the church or going near the altar.
2. **John 13: 4**...Jesus taught the disciples to wash in like manner as above else his disciples would not be taken in his company.
3. **Exodus 40: 30**...Aaron acted upon the injunction of ablution as preached by Moses.

Prostration in Prayer

1. **Genesis 17: 1-4**...Abraham worshipped God on his face.
2. **Numbers 20: 5-6**...Moses and Aaron worshipped God on their faces.
3. **I Chronicles 21: 16-17**...David and elders worshipped God on their faces.
4. **Nehemiah 8: 4-6**...As according to the Law of Moses, the Israelites were led by Ezra to worship God in the same way the Muslims pray.
5. **Matthew 26: 39**...Jesus worshipped God on his face.
6. **Revelation 7: 11-14**...Angels worshipped God on their faces.

Removing footwear at Holy places

1. **Exodus 3: 5**...Moses was commanded to put off his shoes as God was to speak to him.
2. **Joshua 5: 15**...Joshua put off his shoes in the presence of the Arch-angel Gabriel.

3. **Proverbs 20: 1-2**...He who drinks is deprived of his senses.
4. **Habakkuk 2: 15-16**...He is cursed who makes his brother to drink.
5. **Isaiah 5: 11-12**...Cursed are those who follow drinking.
6. **Isiah 5: 22**... Cursed are those who follow drinking.

Usury is Prohibited

1. **Exodus 22: 25**... Do not take interest on the money lent.
2. **Leviticus 25: 36**... Do not take interest on the money lent.
3. **Deuteronomy 23-29**...Do not receive interest on anything lent.

Dead Animals, Pork and Blood are abominable

1. **Genesis 9: 4-10**...Do not eat blood of an animal.
2. **Deuteronomy 14: 21**...Do not eat the flesh of a dead animal.
3. **Deuteronomy 14: 7-8**...Do not eat pork.
4. **Isaiah 65: 3-4**...God is displeased with him who eats pork and thinks himself holy.

The Bible and Polygamy

1. **Genesis 16: 1-2**...Hagar was Abraham's second wife.
2. **Genesis 25: 1**...Keturah was Abraham third wife.
3. **Genesis 29: 17-35**...Jacob was a husband of Leah, Rachel, Bilha and Zilpah.
4. **I Samuel 1: 2**...Samuel's father had two wives.
5. **Deuteronomy 21: 15-17**...God instructs how two women are married at a time.

CHRISTIANITY

Jesus, son of man and Messenger of God

1. **Luke 22: 48**...Jesus called himself the son of man.
2. **John 6: 53**... Jesus called himself the son of man.
3. **Matthew 24: 39**... Jesus called himself the son of man.
4. **John 17: 3**...Jesus was God's messenger.

Son of God is used metaphorically

1. **John 10: 33-39**...If recipients of revelation

can be metaphorically called gods, it will not be wrong if Jesus is called son of God in like manner.

2. **Matthew 5: 9**...Peace makers will be called the children of God.
3. **Exodus 4: 23**...God addressed metaphorically (Jacob) Israel as His first born son.
4. **Luke 22: 69-70**...Jesus called himself son of man.

Singing and clapping of hands is not advisable in worship

1. **Amos 6: 5-6**...Singing, dancing and clapping as in Psalm 150 in worship is not acceptable to God.
2. **Amos 5: 23-24**...Take away from me the noise of your songs.
3. **Ezekiel 25: 6-7**...Punishment awaits for him who sings and claps and rejoices.

The blood of Jesus saves not, but his Words and one's own deeds

1. **John 6: 54-64**...My flesh and blood are nothing but words are life.
2. **Matthew 12: 36-37**...Your good and true words shall give you salvation.
3. **Ezekiel 18: 1-4**...The soul that sins, shall die.

Images are not to be set up for worship

1. **Leviticus 26: 1**...Do not set images up for worship.
2. **Exodus 20: 1-5**... Do not set images up for worship.

Jesus did not die on the Cross; did not ascend to Heaven but went to India and preached to the (Exiled) Lost Sheep of Israel.

Jesus did not die on the Cross

1. **Psalm 22 verses 1, 7, 8, 16, 18 & 24**...A prophecy showing Jesus would be saved from death on the cross.
2. **Matthew 12: 38-40**...Prophet Jona entered the belly of the whale alive; came out alive, in like manner would Jesus enter the sepulchre alive and came out alive.
3. **Matthew 2: 13-20**...God did not want the shedding of the blood of Jesus.
4. **John 7: 1**...Jesus did not want the crucifixion.
5. **John 8: 31-47**...Jesus addressed those who wanted to kill him as ‘murderers and sons of satan’.
6. **Mark 14: 36**...Jesus prayed to God to be saved from death on the cross.
7. **Hebrew 5: 7**...The prayer of Jesus was accepted by God.
8. **John 19: 34**...There was still life in Jesus when blood immediately gushed forth after piercing his side with a spear.
9. **John 19: 38**...Disciples of Jesus knew he was not dead so they treated and dressed his wounds before enshrouding his body.
10. **John 19: 32-33**...Legs of Jesus were not broken to save him from death.
11. **Luke 24: 3**...Jesus did not leave his human body in the sepulchre.

12. **Luke 24: 39-40**...Jesus taught the disciples that wounds and scars could never be found on a ghost of a spirit as he had on his body.
13. **Luke 24: 41-43**...Jesus said ghosts and spirits do not eat the food and in the manner human beings eat.
14. **Deuteronomy 21: 3**...Jesus would be an accursed of God had he died on the cross.
15. **I Corinthians 12: 3**...No godly man would call Jesus accursed.

Jesus did not ascend to Heaven

1. **Luke 34: 51**...Revised standard version of Luke 24: 51 reveals that ‘AND WAS CARRIED TO HEAVEN’ was added by an Ancient Authority.
2. **Ezekiel 34: 6: 36: 6-9; 35: 16-23; 34: 6-23**; Most of the Israelites were taken into exile 721 years before Jesus.
3. **Matthew 15: 23-26**...Jesus was to seek the (exiled) the lost sheep of Israel.
4. **John 10: 6**...Jesus promised he would leave Israel for some place in search of the lost sheep of Israel.

He lived among the exiled people—the Kashmiris in India – preached to them and died at an old age of 120 years as authenticated by **Encyclopedia Britannica** Edition 14, Volume 13, plate I under the Article: JESUS CHRIST.
